

First Aid / CPR

Emergency Medical Responder - \$300 This course, previously known as First Responder, is an all inclusive course that provides the student with the knowledge and skills to successfully respond to most emergency medical scenarios. Public Safety Academy is a State of Florida approved provider of the EMR Course.

Trauma First Response - \$ 125 one-day course that teaches the principles of Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) to non-EMS practitioners, including first responders, police officers, and security personnel.

Heartsaver / AED CPR - \$35 Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation course for the lay person. This course is for employees and/or designated first responders who have a duty to respond to a cardiac emergency because of job responsibilities or regulatory requirements.

All CPR classes are instructed in accordance with American Heart Association guidelines. American Heart Association CPR cards are awarded to students that successfully complete CPR courses.

Emergency Medical Responder course includes CPR for Healthcare Provider, and Bloodborne Pathogens. No other fees are required for the EMR Course. Students will have the option to take the NREMT Emergency Medical Responder Exam at a NREMT testing site. NREMT fees ARE NOT included in EMR course fees.

Security Officer Handgun Certification

Florida "G" License Class

28 hour class required for the State of Florida Statewide Firearm License ("G" License). Successful completion of the class also meets the requirements for the Florida Concealed Weapon or Firearms License.

This course follows the same format and content as the law enforcement basic recruit firearms class given at law enforcement academies.

Topics include:

- Florida Statutes
- Firearm Safety
- Revolvers
- Semi-automatic Pistols
- Handgun Fundamentals/Marksmanship
- Drawing and Holstering Handguns
- Cover and Concealment

Students are required to pass 2 qualification courses of fire.

- Daytime Qualification Course
- Florida G License Qualification Course

This is a NRA Law Enforcement Approved course. Course Completion Certificate will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

Duration: 28 Hours
Tuition: \$150

Florida "G" Advanced Training

This is an add on to the 28 hour class or can be taken by the "G" licensed holder. The additional training covers:

- Reduced Light/Low Visibility
- Decision Making
- Tactical Movement
- Tactical Reloads

Students are required to pass the Reduced Light/Low Visibility Qualification Course. The student will receive a NRA Law Enforcement Course Completion Certificate for successful completion of this course.

Florida "D" License Class Part I

This course satisfies Florida's requirements for initial training as a security officer.
